We have received the following updated guidance from Welsh Government this afternoon. It is to be shared with all parents.

Wearing of face coverings (All schools)

The Welsh Government has updated its guidance on the use of face coverings in schools.

To reduce the risk of transmission amongst parents and relatives, please wear face coverings when visiting the school, and when dropping off and picking up your children. Maintaining clear social distancing at the school gates will also reduce risk and set a good example to pupils.

Along with regular hand washing and social distancing, this will reduce the risk of spreading COVID -19 at school as far as possible.

The rules have been made stronger to keep you and your families as safe as possible and are based on advice from the Welsh Government's Technical Advisory Group, as they learn more about transmission of the virus.
